Dear Parents/ Guardians of Secondary One Students,

The following information highlights some key events that are taking place in Term 3.

### 1. Early Dismissal on 8 July 2025

The O-Level Mother Tongue Languages (MTL) Listening Comprehension Examination will be conducted on Tuesday, 8 July 2025. To facilitate the conduct of the examinations, all students from Sec 1 to 5 will be dismissed at 12.15pm.

#### 2. Home-Based Learning (HBL) days on 15, 16 and 17 July 2025

The N-Level and O-Level English Language and Mother Tongue Languages Oral Examinations will be conducted throughout the day on 15, 16 and 17 July 2025.

To facilitate the conduct of the examinations, these days will be designated as HBL days. All students from Sec 1 to 5 are not expected to come to school. Lesson instructions will be made available via the RSS HBL microsite.

#### 3. Term 3 Weighted Assessment (4 to 16 August 2025)
